- Acting for a leading Canadian bank in a class action regarding its business practices with respect to foreign exchange conversion fees on direct brokerage transactions;

This was the first time a provisional administrator was able to seize cryptocurrency (Bitcoin) in the context of its mandate.

- Acting for shareholders or various companies in the context of oppression remedy and directors' liability;
